Project Description: The Snorre B floater is an integrated production, drilling and quarters (PDQ) unit. Processed oil is transported via a 30-kilometre pipeline to Statoil's Statfjord B fixed platform for storage and offloading. Recoverable reserves in the Snorre B area are estimated at about 365 million barrels of oil. Production capacity stands at approximately 110,000 barrels per day.

Scope of Work: Our SOW consisted on the construction engineering, partial procurement, fabrication, load out and sea fastening of the semi submersible hull. The final dimensions of the hull were 85mx85mx45m.

According to the OTC 2002 paper 14224, the Snorre B Hull is "the most complete hull ever delivered from a yard. Less than 1 % of the total hull work was carry over."
